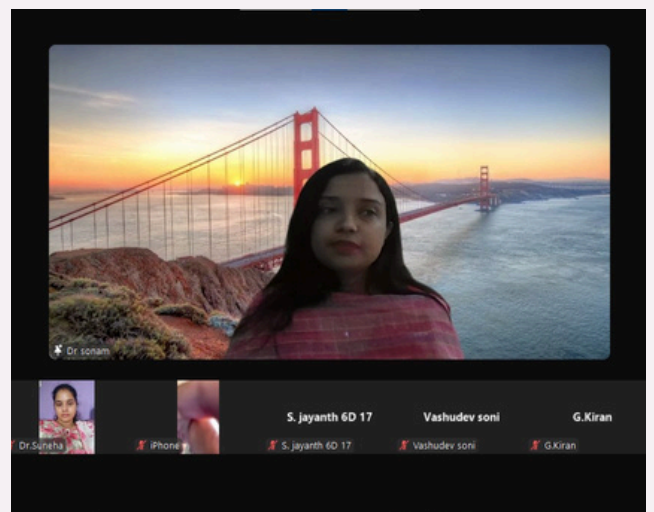
Akshara Vaagdevi International School Hosts Successful Webinar on Adolescence

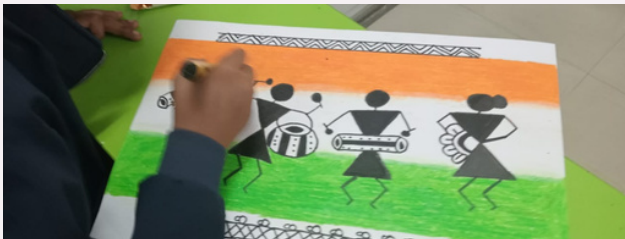

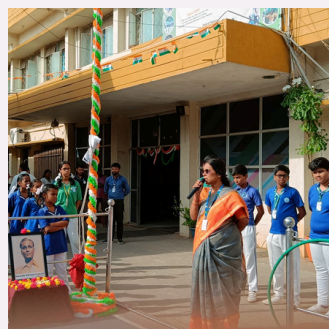

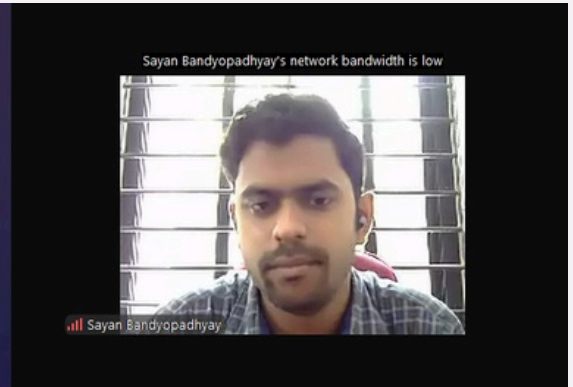
