A big round of applause to all the participants for their amazing performances. You all brought so much joy to our hearts.





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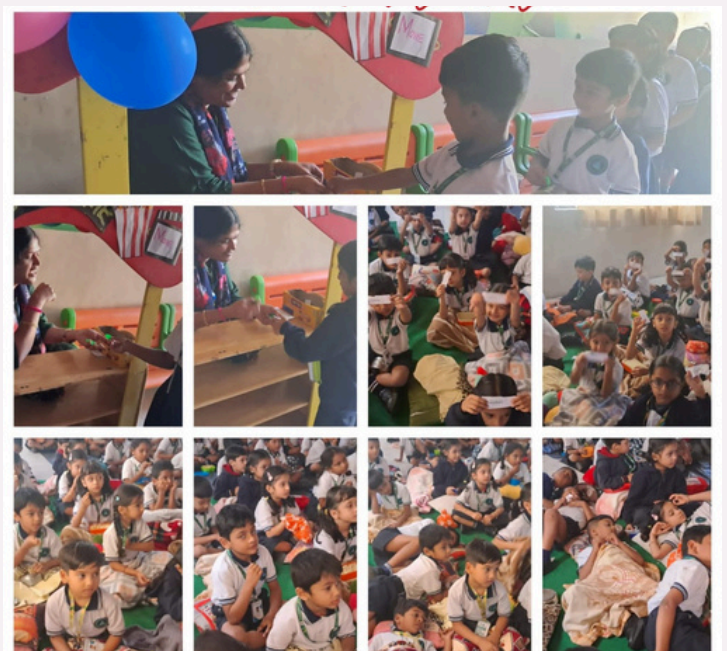
## "Popcorn Movie Time"
